

Introduction to Competency Tracker

Competency Tracker, formerly known as Fisdap Skills Tracker, documents student learning, reports achievement and growth, and aids program accreditation and self-study. Using Competency Tracker, students can document their field, clinical, and lab experiences within the Fisdap website, while educators can see what students accomplish, at which sites, and provide feedback as needed. This allows for ease of reporting and tracking of student growth, encouraging student accountability and accuracy. With Competency Tracker, you'll be able to better track student performance and help students better understand their strengths and weaknesses.

Additionally, with the release of Competency Tracker, we've added new features and made improvements upon what used to be available in Fisdap Skills Tracker, including updates to meet the new **CoAEMSP Student Minimum Competency (SMC) Recommendations Report (2023)**.

Some of these key improvements include, but are not limited to, the following:

- **NEW** ability to add more than two impressions, allowing students to record more details of their assessment of a patient during shifts
- **NEW** option to add comments to each individual skill performed
- **NEW** ability to duplicate add multiple skill entries at once
- **NEW** option to add attachments, such as images, videos, and files/documents, on a shift-level to individual items or impressions
- **NEW** speech-to-text dictation for comments and narrative
- **NEW** goal set template created specifically to address the new CoAEMSP Student Minimum Competency (SMC) Recommendations Report (2023)
- Fully customizable goal sets
- Enhanced search functionality and improved user interface (UI) design
