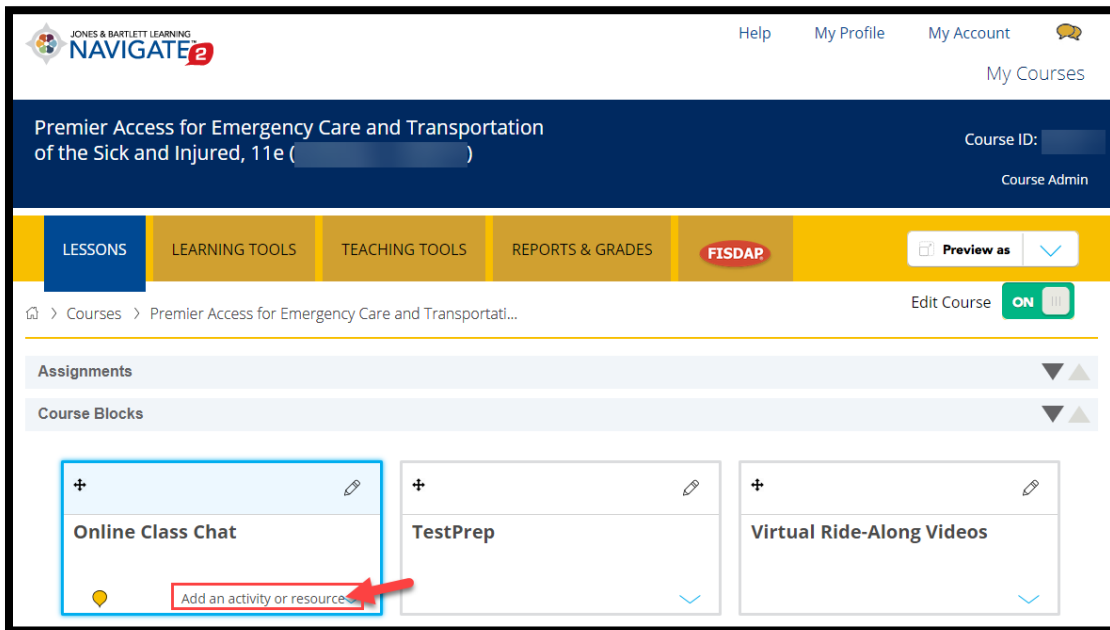


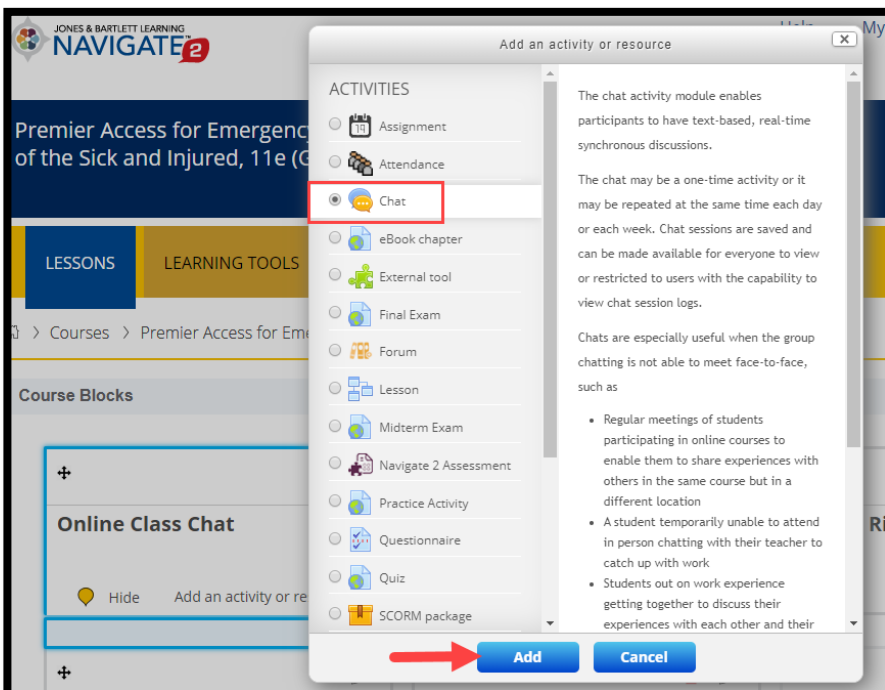
## How to setup a live chat session within Navigate 2

This document outlines steps for creating an online chat room for participants withing your Navigate 2 course. The chat feature may be used to enable real-time correspondence of all course participants within a centralized module under a topic chosen by the instructor.

1. From the **LESSONS** tab, ensure you have **Course editing** mode turned **On**, hover your mouse pointer over the chapter or course topic in which you want to add the **Chat** activity, and then click **Add activity or resource**.




2. In the resulting popup window, select the dial to the left of the **Chat** option and click the **Add** button.

3. The next page displays all settings available to manage your new **Chat** activity. All fields labeled with an asterisk (\*) are required to successfully save and activate the chat room. These include **name** and **description**.




Adding a new Chat to Online Class Chat



4. Scrolling down this page, you may use the **Next chat time** field to set the time and date for when the next chat session in the course should opened and used. Please note, this will add the chat to a student's **Upcoming events** and course **Calendar**, however it will not prevent them from contributing to the chat thread before or after the designated time.

5. If you would like to program the chat room as a recurring instance, use the **Repeat/publish session times** field to select the desired cadence.



7. When satisfied with your selections, scroll to the bottom of the page and click the **Save and return to course** or **Save and display** buttons.
