 - Simply type in the student authorization number located on the course completion card. The search tool will reveal the name of the course the student completed, the expiration date, and up to the first four letters of the student's last name.
- 3) All ECSI course completion cards are valid for 2 years from the date of issue, except for Bloodborne & Airborne Pathogens which is valid for 1 year from the date of issue.
